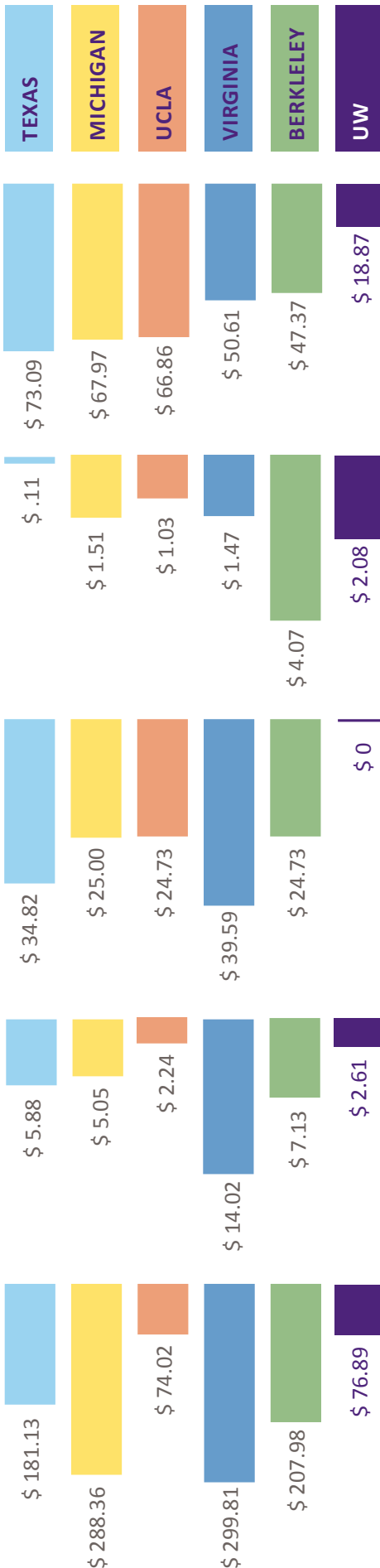


REVENUE AND RESERVES



TOTAL REVENUE AVAILABLE

The total revenue available to UW Law is dramatically lower than the top five. This includes tuition, gifts, grants, other revenue and state support.

GRANT REVENUE

UW Law does extremely well in the area of grant revenue, second only to Berkeley in the amount of revenue from training and research grants. Overall, however, this is a very small piece of the revenue picture and all funds must be targeted only at the scope of the grant – usually a fairly narrow project.

OPERATING RESERVES

UW has no operating reserve. Indeed, this area is one that distinguishes it dramatically from peers. While this does not directly affect ranking, it leaves the school without a safety net or a source of funds for new strategic investment.

For the past several years, the Law School has broken its own giving records; however, it must receive significant increases to be competitive with the other schools.
